

CELEBRATE –

and remember ...

- ✿ Always read and follow label directions.
- ✿ Use outdoors only on a hard, flat and level surface, not on grass or gravel. If you are using fireworks on grass, (Not recommended) then you should lay down a strong piece of plywood as a shooting surface to insure the stability of the items as you use them.
- ✿ Use fireworks in a clear, open area, making sure the area overhead is free from obstructions.
- ✿ Always have water handy (a garden hose and a bucket).
- ✿ Never experiment or make your own fireworks.
- ✿ Light only one firework at a time.
- ✿ Never re-light a “dud” firework (wait 15 to 20 minutes and then soak it in a bucket of water).
- ✿ Children should never, handle, play with or light fireworks.
- ✿ If necessary, store fireworks in a cool, dry place.
- ✿ Dispose of fireworks properly by soaking them in water and then disposing of them in your trashcan.
- ✿ Never throw or point fireworks at other people. Spectators should be at least 75 feet from the shooting site.
- ✿ Never carry fireworks in your pocket.
- ✿ Never shoot fireworks in metal or glass containers.
- ✿ The shooter should always wear eye protection and never have any part of the body over the firework.
- ✿ Stay away from illegal explosives.
- ✿ Have a designated shooter; alcohol and fireworks do not mix.
